

#### Dear Families,

Supplemental education and learning supports means that the learner and instructor are separated and therefore can't meet in a traditional classroom setting. Due to the extended school closure, our district has provided resources and guidance to supplement learning at home. We hope that families can partner with children to complete some of these activities daily. Some will include learning with devices and technology, while others do not. Feel free to choose the activities you and your child wish to do. Our district will also be coordinating additional materials and 5-day plan packets that families may choose to pick up from meal sites or from the school district office. Materials included in paper packets and supplies delivered to meal sites are marked in the 5-day plans with a \*. A general recommendation from our instructors is to set aside some time each day for your child(ren) to read, write, speak, do math, get some exercise, and help one another. A schedule is nice, but remember to be flexible and have fun.
