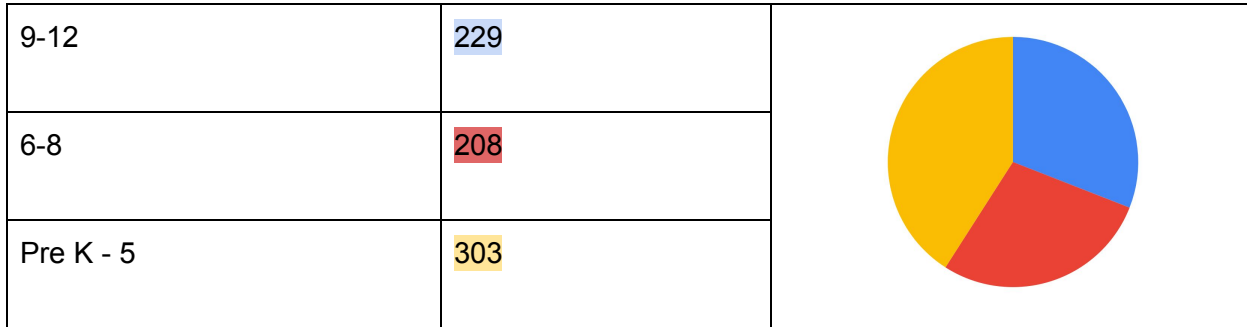


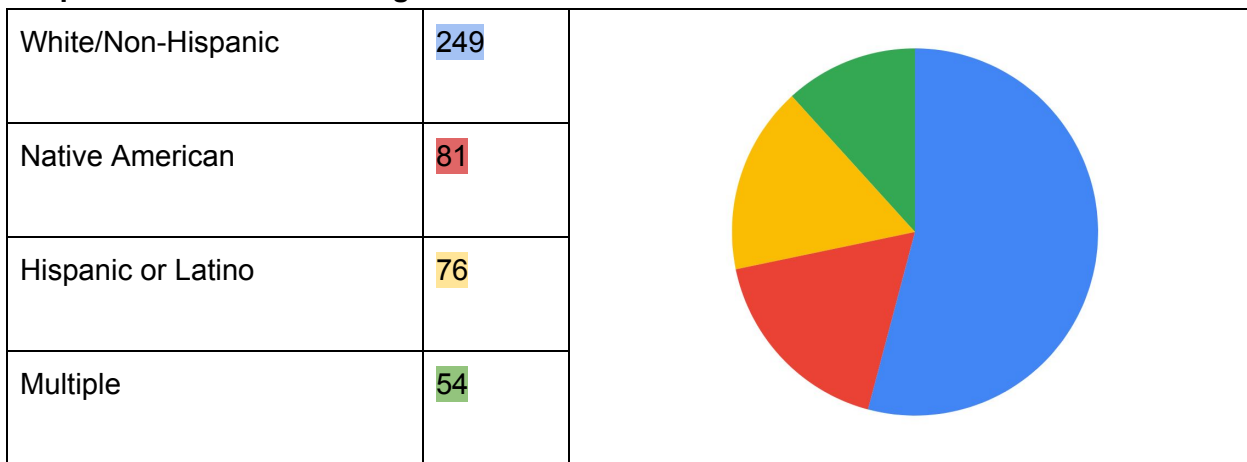
Family Input #1 -- Distance Learning Feedback Analysis
