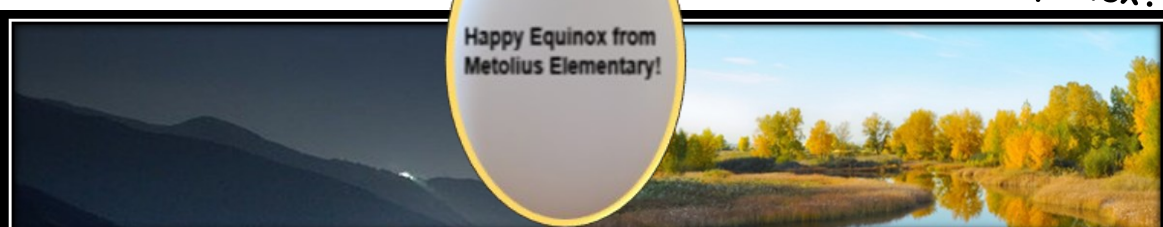

Is it Precision & Patience or Gravitational Pull of the Equinox?



Metolius Elementary, Happy Equinox - You'll have to ask the staff and students at Metolius Elementary whether it is precision and patience or the gravitational pull of the autumnal equinox, but from the pictures it's obvious they enjoyed the experiment. Way to go Metolius Elementary!

Equinox (Wikipedia) - An equinox is commonly regarded as the instant of time when the plane (extended indefinitely in all directions) of Earth's equator passes through the geometric center of the Sun's disk. This occurs twice each year, around 20 March and 23 September. In other words, it is the moment at which the center of the visible Sun is directly above the equator.
