Summer College Classes for Madras High and Bridges High Students

These classes are offered free of cost to students thanks to a grant provided by the Oregon Community Foundation and the 509J school district



COMM 111 - Public Speaking (July 19-August 26, 10:30am-1:00pm)

This class is required for many COCC programs. It will be held in-person at the Madras COCC campus. COMM 111 is designed to assist public speakers with content, organization, delivery and speech anxiety.

HD 100CS - College Success (July 26-August 13, 8:00am-10:00am)

This class is required for most COCC programs. It will be held in-person at the Madras COCC campus. HD100CS is designed to give new students a broad overview of college and life success strategies.

HHP 252 - First Aid & BLS Provider CPR (August 16-18, 8:00am-5:00pm)

HHP courses are required for most COCC programs. The lecture portion of this class will be held virtually and the CPR portion will be held in-person at the Madras COCC campus. This course highlights first aid basics and CPR certification. It includes a CPR card valid for two-years.
