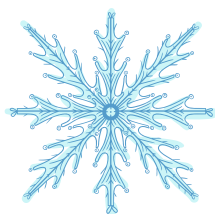




# Schools in Action

## Students Flourish Here

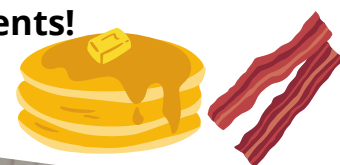

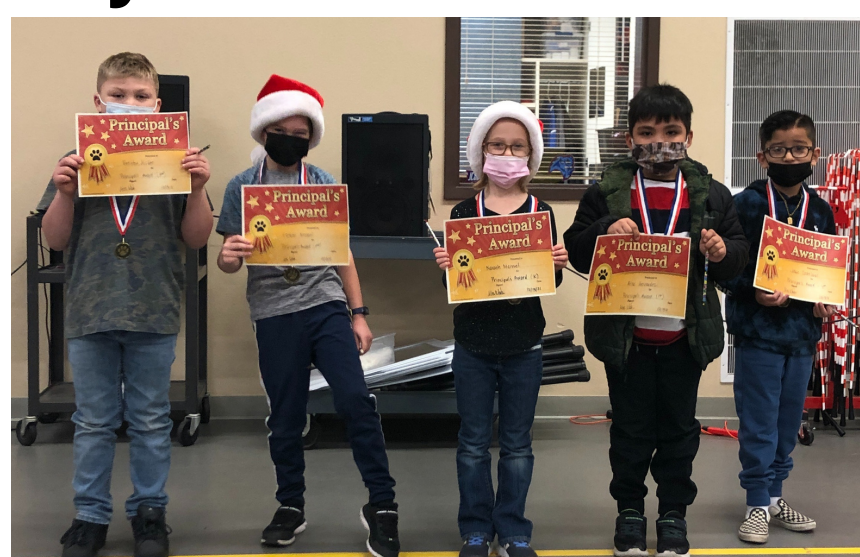
