Wednesday, June 1 st	Senior Sneak @ Washington Family Ranch. Seniors must arrive at MHS by 8:00 am for bag checks. Bus departs 8:15 am. Students must ride the MHS bus to join the senior sneak at Washington Family Ranch.
Thursday, June 2 nd	Senior Scholarship Awards Ceremony- Seniors must report to MHS by 7:45 am for line up instructions. Senior Awards and Scholarship Ceremony to start at 10:00 am at the Performing Arts Center. Seniors will be wearing their cap and gowns at this event (cap and gowns only, no stoles, cords or tassels for this event please). Directly following the Senior Scholarship Awards Ceremony, seniors will have the opportunity to “Walk the Halls” of their previous 509J schools. Buses will take students out to Metolius Elementary, Buff Elementary, Madras Elementary, JCMS and WSK8. <i>This event is mandatory for seniors wanting to “walk” at the graduation ceremony.</i>
