- Principal Challenge
 - At the end of quarter 3 (April 13, 2023), students that meet all the following criteria will earn an activity ($\frac{1}{2}$ day) with the administration.
 - A GPA above 3.5 or improving their GPA from quarter 2 to quarter 3 one (1) GPA point (Example: From 1.9 to 2.9)
 - Less than 3 absences
 - Less than 3 tardies
 - No discipline referrals

 - \circ This was the first semi-formal event at JCMS planned by our leadership class and was a tremendous success.
