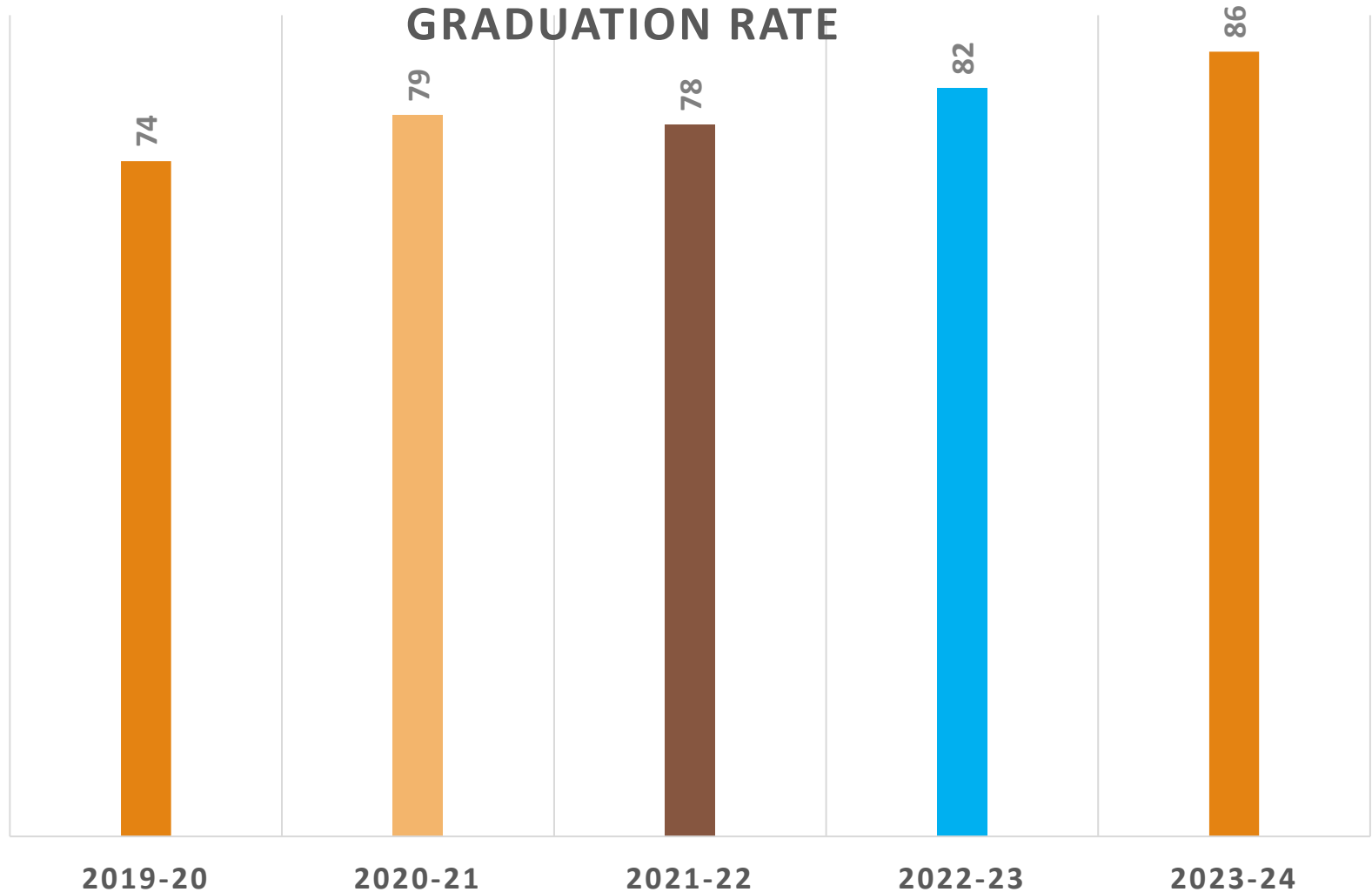


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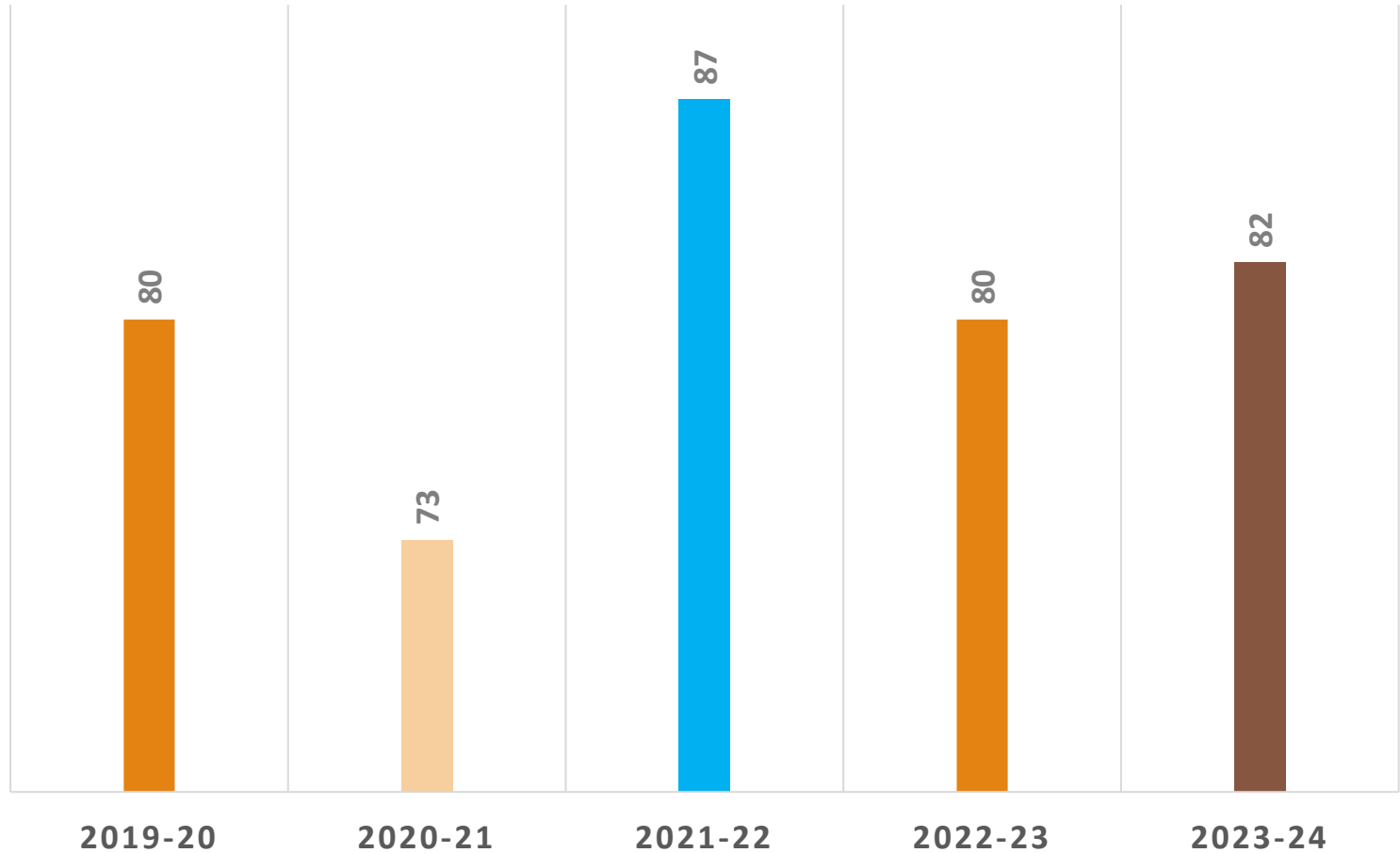

GRADUATION RATE**



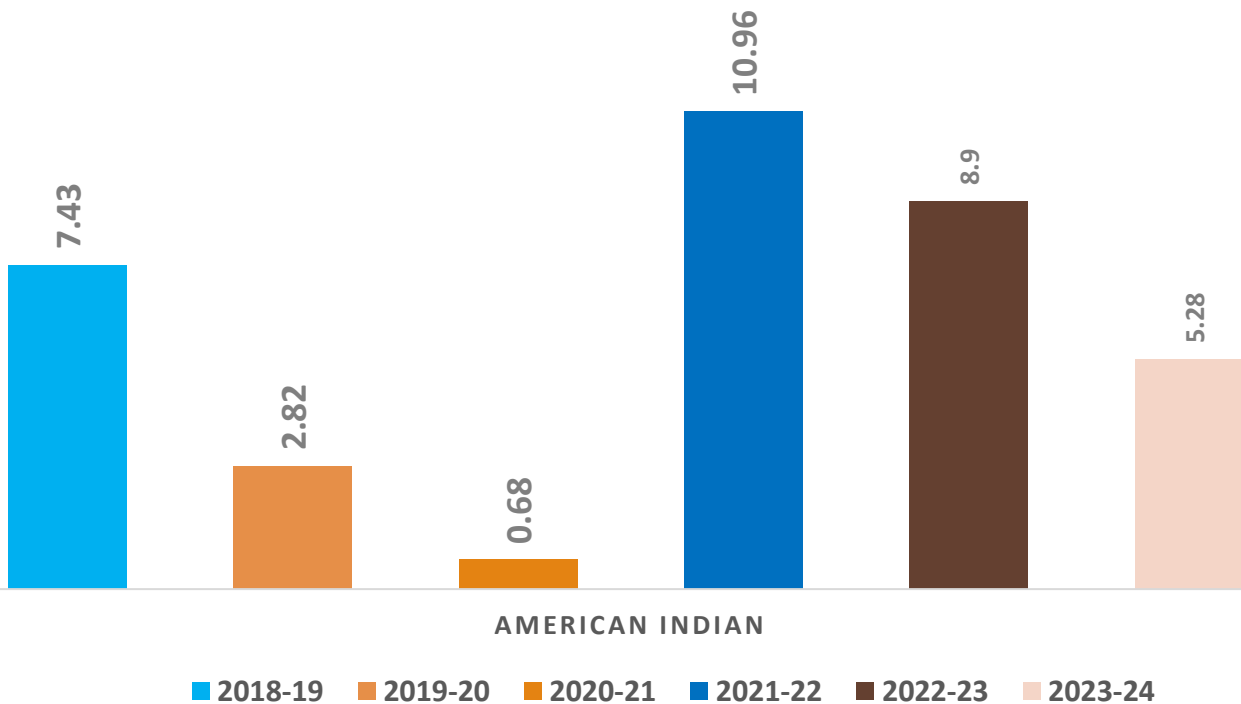

Native American Students Five Year Graduation Data**



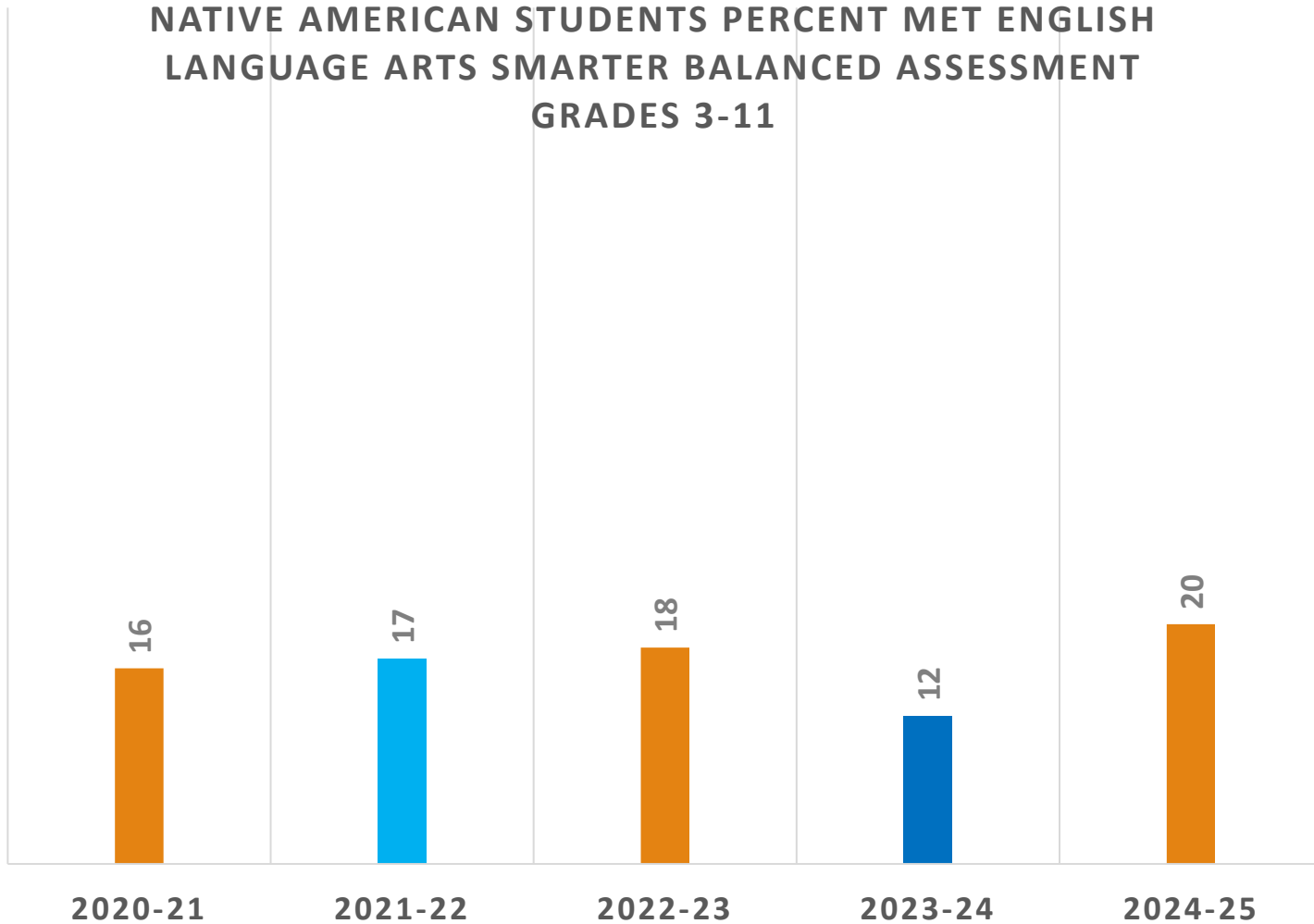

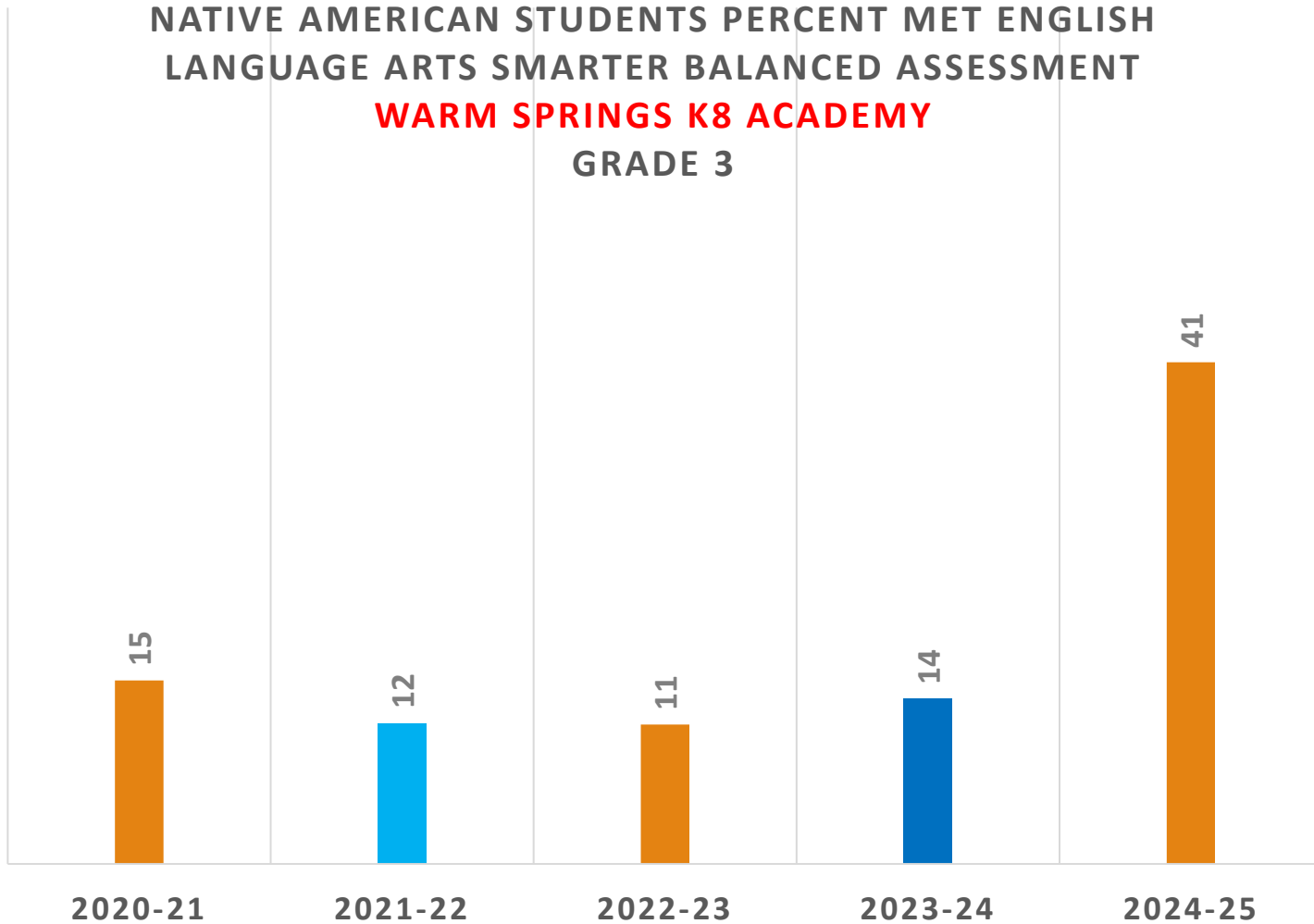

GRADES 3-11**



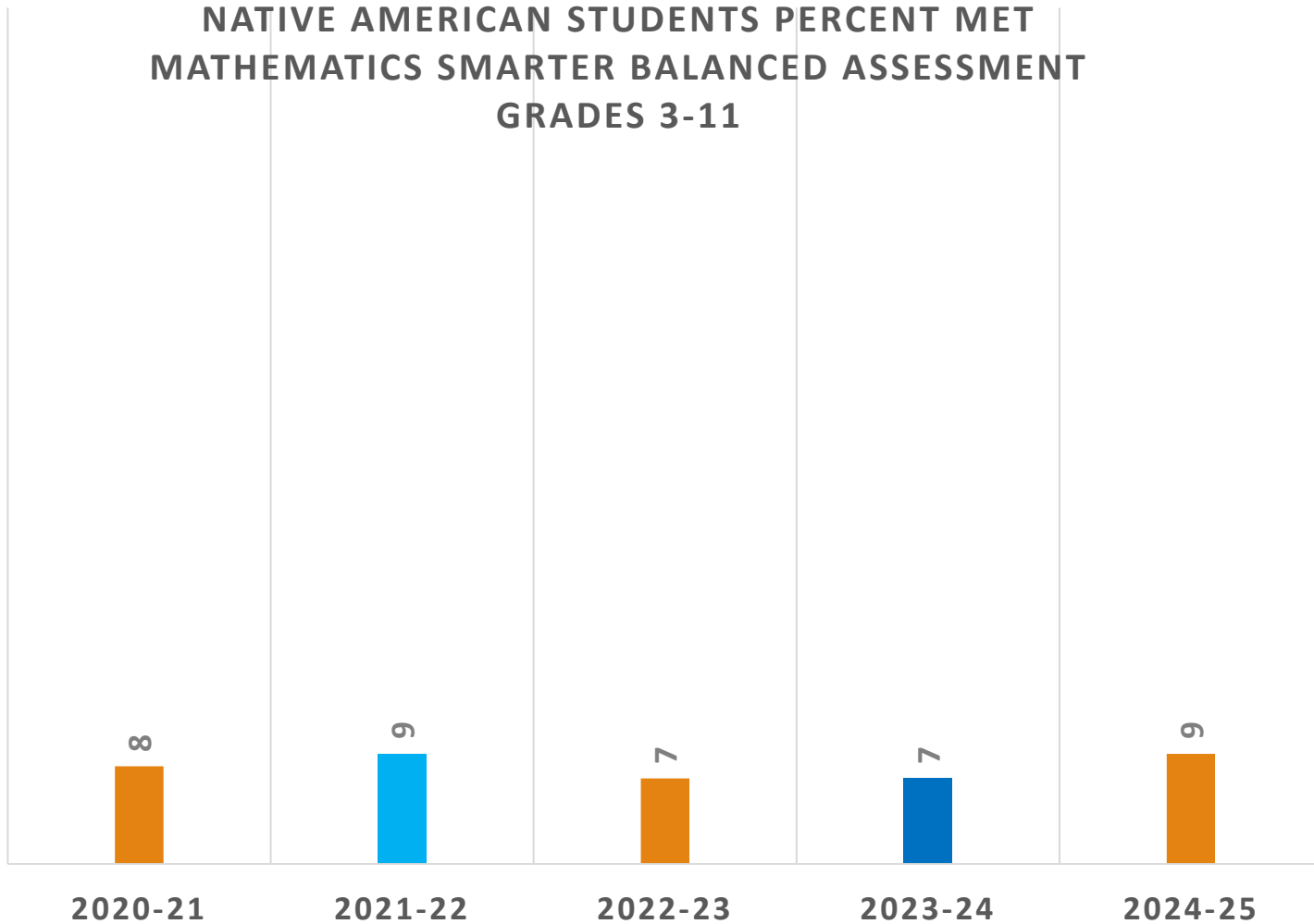

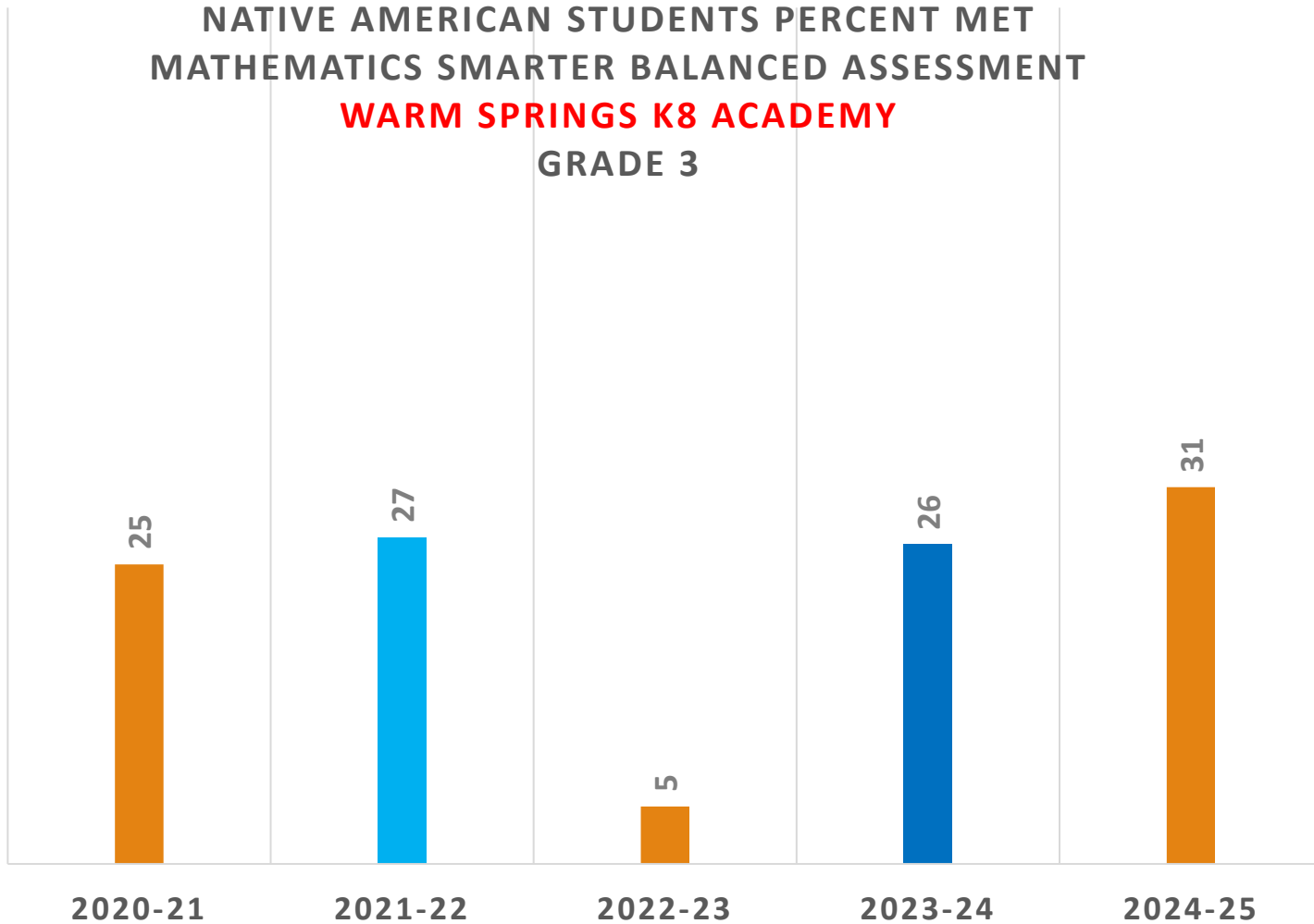


**NATIVE AMERICAN STUDENTS PERCENT MET

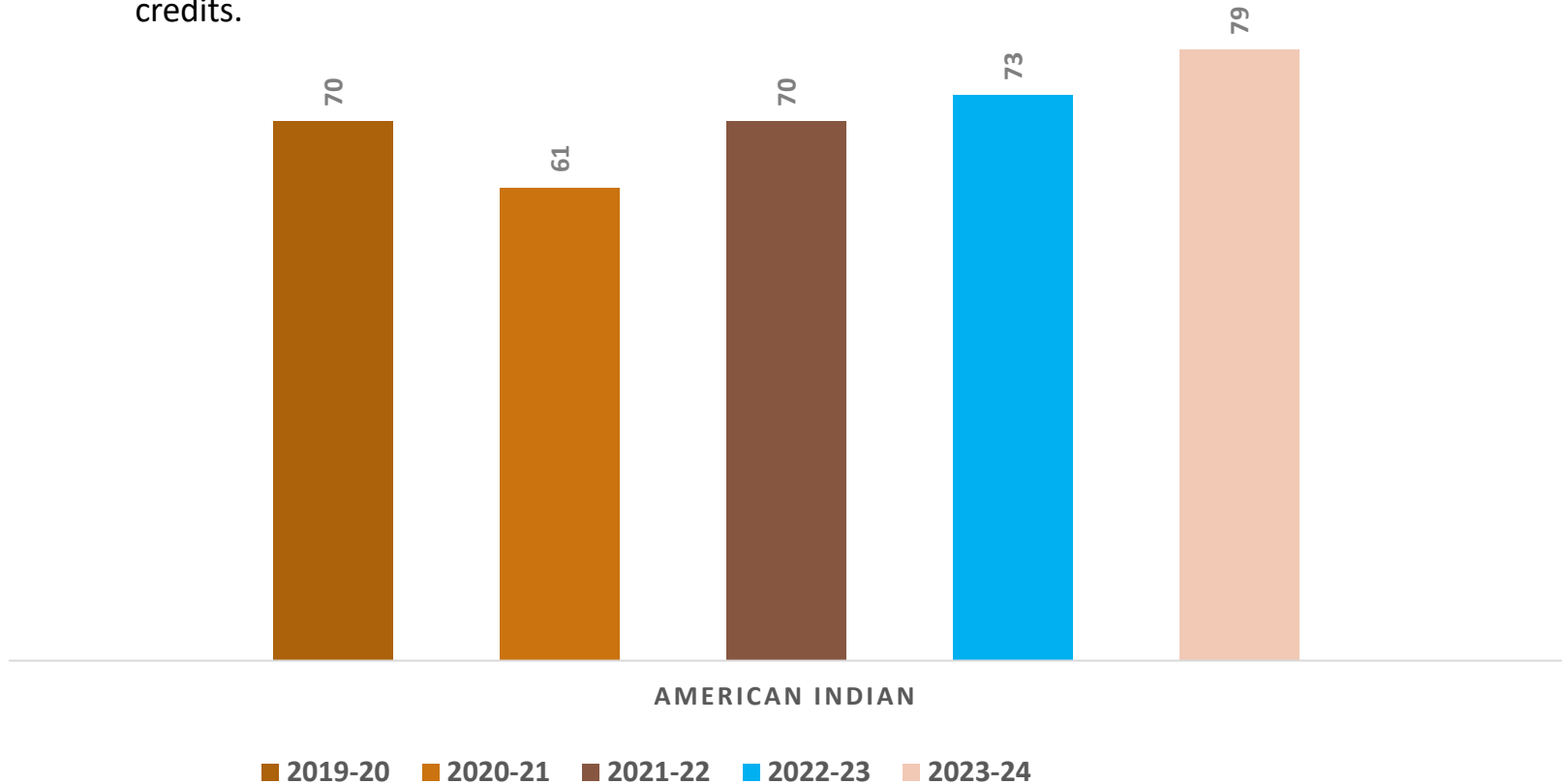

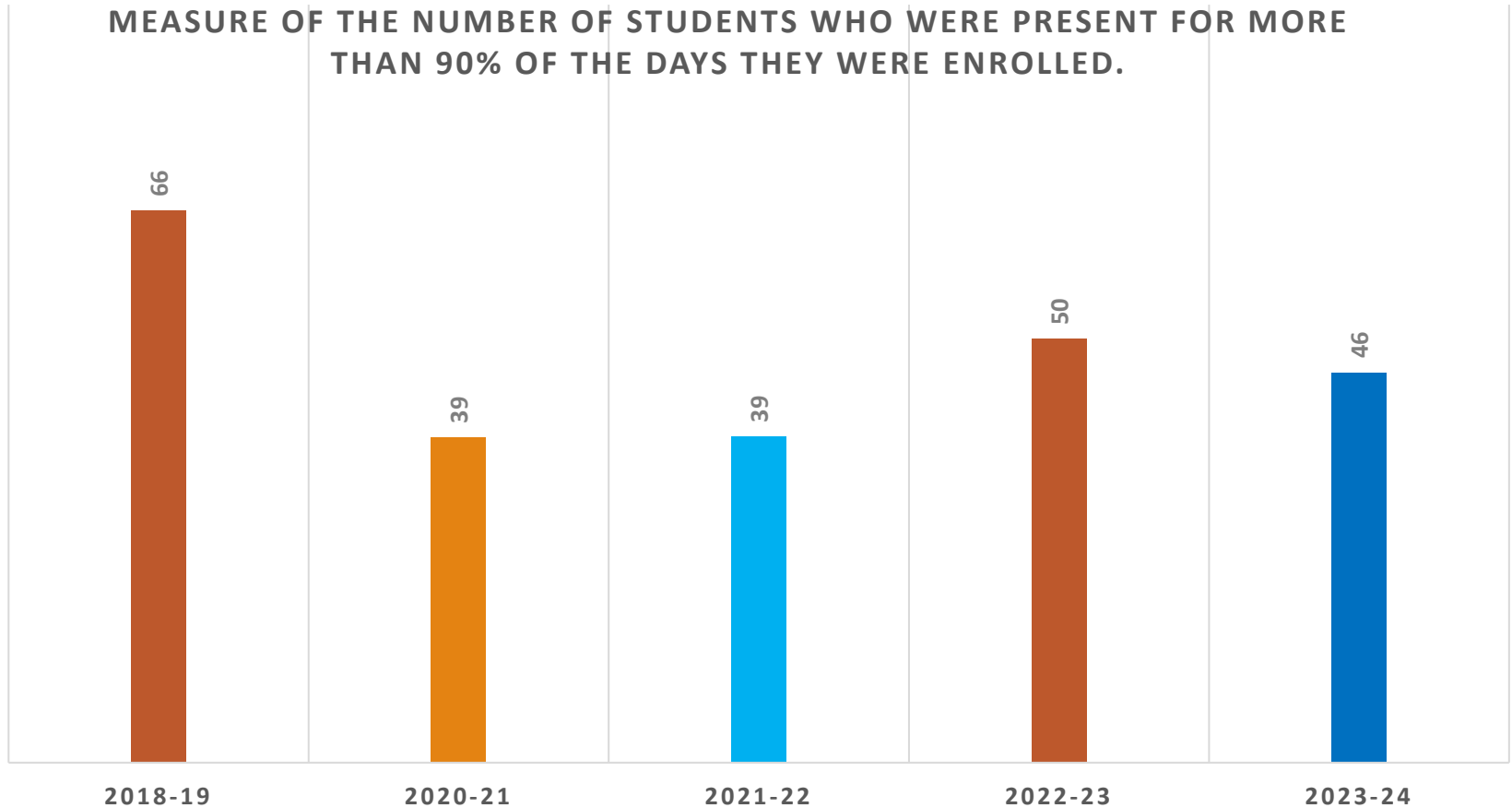
9TH GRADE ON TRACK

NATIVE AMERICAN STUDENTS REGULAR ATTENDERS

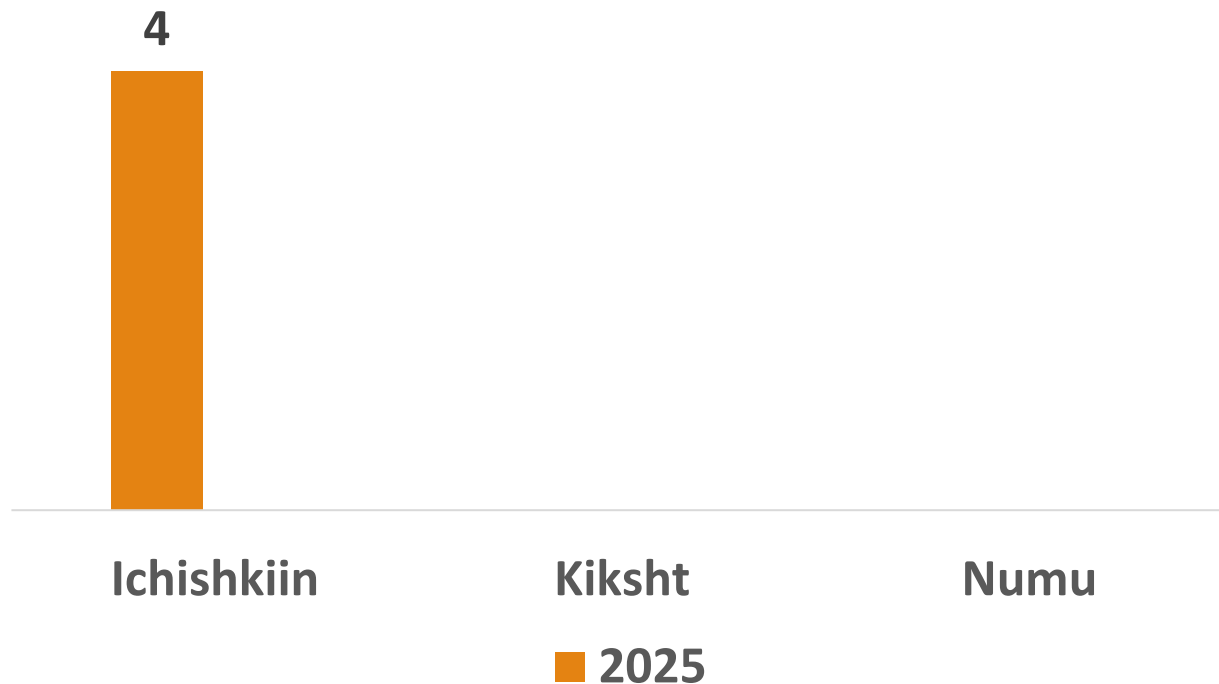
